ABSTRACT

Social protection enterprises, which usually transfer income or resources to the poor, are planned to protect vulnerable people against livelihood threats, and seek to enhance the social status and rights of the banished. These are the instruments of social protection in Pakistan (i) Social Security/Social Insurance, (ii) Social Assistance, (iii) Labor Market Programs and (iv) Micro and area-based safeguards for the informal sector. The present study was examine “The Role of social protection policies in poverty reduction in rural areas of district Chiniot”. The study was conducted in district Chiniot. Two tehsils was selected randomly and three union councils (U.C) was selected from each tehsil. For this study 150 respondents was selected by simple random sampling technique, the face to face interview schedule was used for data collection.
